EARNING THE CHFP DESIGNATION

You earn the CHFP by successfully completing the online certification examination. The exam will consist of 150 multiple choice questions covering six content areas:

- · Contracting

Candidates are allowed 4 hours to complete the examination.

MAINTAINING YOUR CHEP OR FHEMA CERTIFICATION

HFMA members who have earned either the Certified Healthcare Financial Professional (CHFP) or Fellow of HFMA (FHFMA) designation must maintain their certification by meeting two requirements:

- · Remain an active HFMA member in good standing
- Complete 90 contact hours in eligible education programs every three years. In addition:
 - · At least half (45) of these contact hours must be in healthcare finance-related topics
 - \cdot At least 20 contact hours must be completed in each of the three years
