
Revenue Cycle Governance Structure

Revenue cycle strategic initiatives and projects require a governance structure to determine decision-making authority and establish monitoring and oversight of planned initiatives. In this model, standing committees were established based on the revenue cycle organization chart. The standing committees are responsible for monitoring project progress and reporting regularly to the steering committee. The standing committees chartered ad hoc groups to manage complicated initiatives with an expectation that regular, standardized communications were made up to the steering committee.
