Risk Adjustment Methodology



A statistical process that takes into account the underlying health status and health spending of the enrollees in an insurance plan when looking at their health care outcomes or health care costs

– *Healthcare.gov*

What are HCCs?

CMS-HCCs were developed out of the need for a comprehensive risk adjustment methodology

1980

→ Hospital Model DRG implemented

1997

→ Balance Budget Act of 1997: Mandated Risk Adjustment Payment Models

2004

→ Implementation of HCC Model

2022

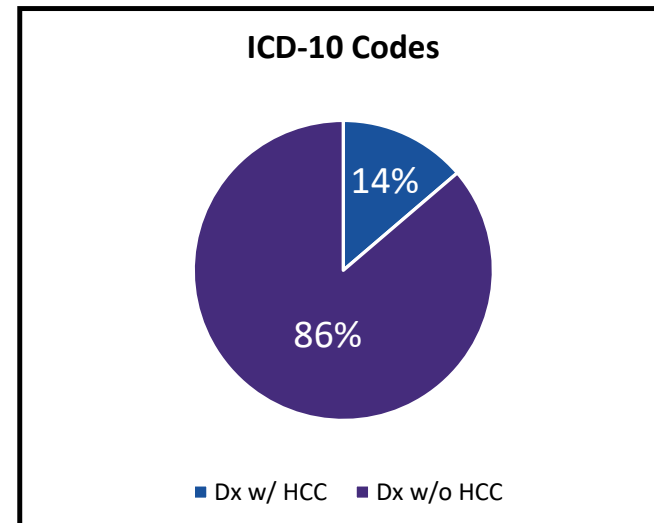
→ Model refined for increased accuracy

Hierarchical Condition Category (HCC)



The HCC model ranks diagnoses into categories that represent conditions with similar cost patterns

- Only long-term illnesses are assigned an HCC
 - ✓ Diabetes
 - ✓ Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
 - ✓ Chronic heart failure (CHF)
- Acute illnesses and injuries are not reliable predictors of ongoing healthcare costs



Of the over 70,000 ICD-10 codes, only 14% map to an HCC

What are HCCs?

| Diagnosis | Coefficients | HCC # |
|---|-----------------|-------------------|
| E10.9 – Diabetes without Complication | .107 | HCC 19 |
| I73.9 – Vascular Disease | .294 | HCC 108 |
| E09.49 - Diabetes with Chronic Complications | .340 | HCC 18 |
| C67.0 - Colorectal, Bladder, and Other Cancers | .317 | HCC 11 |
| C34.10 - Lung and Other Severe Cancers | 1.01 | HCC 9 |
| W59.22XA – Struck by Turtle, Initial encounter | 0.00 | - |
| Patient Total HCC | 1.64 | |

- The current year HCC model only explains 12.46% of cost variation⁽¹⁾

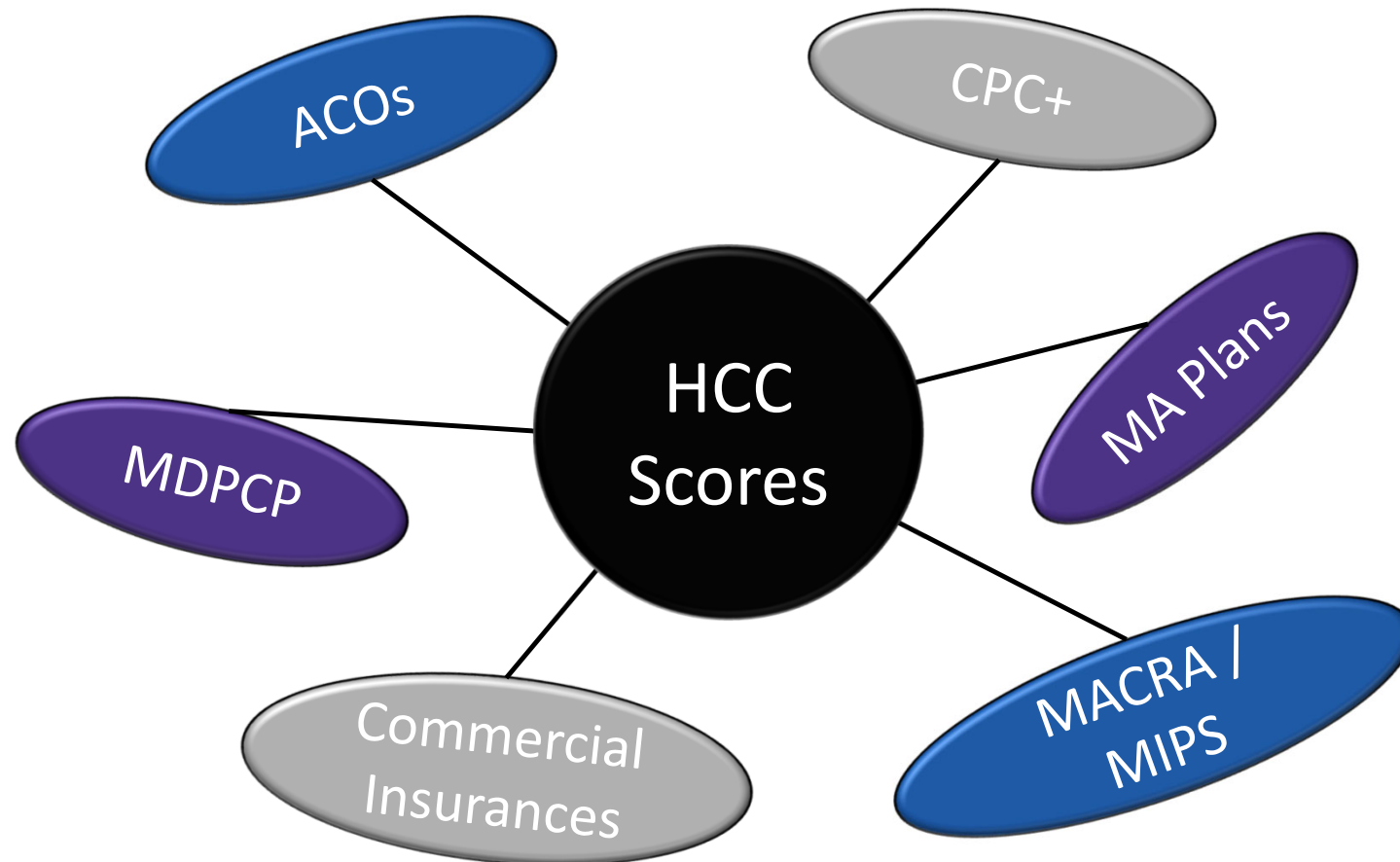
