OUR FIRST ONE-DAY INSTITUTE AND CHAPTER MEETING WILL BE HELD IN SPOKANE, FRIDAY, NOVEMBER
20TH. Time and place of meeting in Spokane will be announced later.

At the annual meeting of the Washington State Hospital Association a motion was passed asking that the Association Board of Trustees encourage the adoption of uniform accounting principles for hospitals of the State. It is felt that the hospitals will be called upon to substantiate more adequately their operating costs when negotiating with the various governmental agencies.

It is true in the hospital field throughout the State, every institution has its own interpretation of accounting terminology and makes its own decision as to its needs in financial information and as a result, comparisons are generally of little or no value to our Administrators or our Association Secretary.

Today better than 70 per cent of the nation's Hospitals are depending on the AHA chart of accounts and I firmly believe that one of the greatest services we, as hospital accountants can render to the field is to participate in the adoption of a uniform chart of accounts throughout all hospitals. The trend toward uniform accounting is definitely in the air and if I sound like a salesman, I plead guilty.
