Flex vs. Classic Version of Cvent

The Flex version of Cvent will have the same functionality as the Classic module; but will provide more features and functionality. The Classic version of this event management software (Cvent) will eventually sunset. This version is expected to sunset sometime in 2020.

Where are registration settings in Flex?

In Classic Events, changing settings, customizing your site, and adding questions were all done on separate pages. With Flex, all three are now centralized in the Site Designer. To access the Site Designer, hover over Website & Registration and, under Registration, click Registration Process.
