Fundamentals of Healthcare Reporting - Cori Schoenke, Partner, Wipfli



We will discuss the principles of healthcare financial reporting going through, in detail, elements of the balance sheet, statement of operations, statement of changes in net assets, statement of cash flows, and required footnote disclosures – all from a healthcare perspective. Revenue Cycle Management - John Bartell, Director, Revenue Cycle, Fort Healthcare



The Revenue Cycle Management is an examination of the processes that impact both the patient and the provider of service from the point of entry into the provider's system to a zero balance on the patient's account. We will examine the components of the Revenue Cycle, the metrics used to analyze effectiveness, the market conditions that impact it, and the future of health care reform. Attendees will acquire a better understanding of healthcare revenue cycle operations and those elements that impact it.
