BREAST CANCER AWARENESS <u>AND</u> ACTION MONTH

1 in 8 women will be diagnosed with breast cancer

Over 340K cases of breast cancer will be diagnosed this year

Estimated 2022 deaths: over 43K women and over 530 men

1 in 6 breast cancers are found in women ages 40-49

Yearly mammograms beginning at age 40
