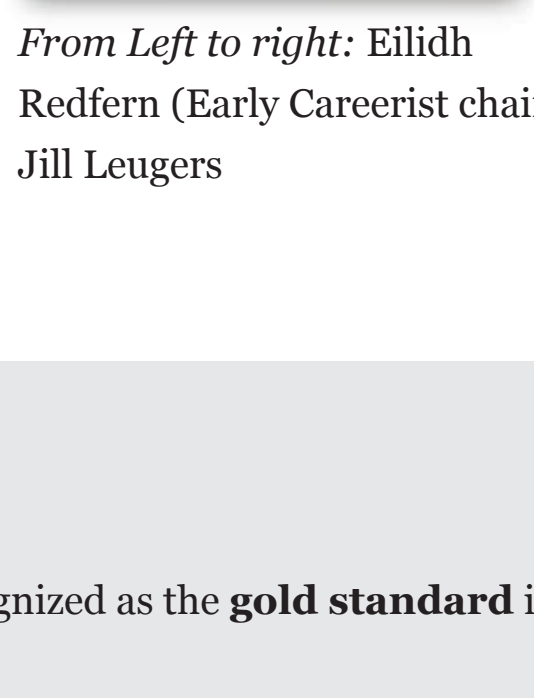

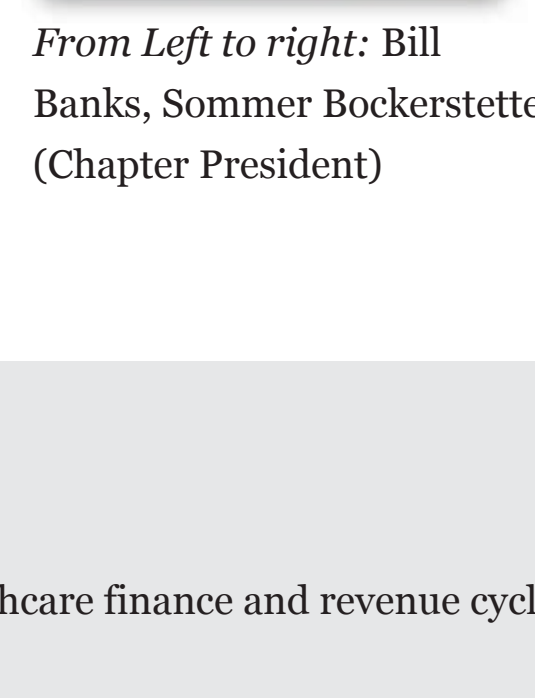

Achieving the designation as a Certified Healthcare Finance Professional (CHFP) continues to be one of the most strategic and career-advancing moves that members can make – especially in today's competitive and ever-changing healthcare landscape.

The ideal CHFP certification program candidate is a management-level professional with 3-5 years of experience.

The program is designed for:

- Professional staff: New to field or early careerists
- Management: Experienced, seeking to advance career
- Executive leaders: Experienced, need to develop staff
- Those who aspire to be managers or leaders in healthcare roles (clinical, non-clinical, providers, vendors and payers)

The exam breaks down into two online courses, called modules. Both modules must be successfully completed in order to earn CHFP status.

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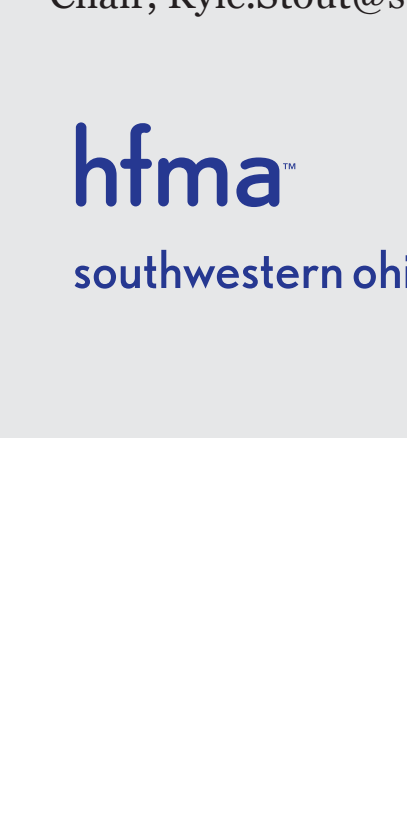
